

# HPV Vaccines and Cancer



## The vaccination works.

- ✓ The human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination was introduced to the U.S. in 2006. Since then, infections with HPV types that cause related cancers and genital warts have dropped 88% among teens.
- ✓ Research has also shown that fewer people are developing cervical pre-cancers (abnormal cells on the cervix that can lead to cancer).



## Does the vaccine cause fertility complications?

- Fertility is a person's ability to get pregnant. The HPV vaccine doesn't cause fertility problems.
- Not getting HPV vaccine does leave people vulnerable to HPV cancers and pre-cancers.
- People who develop a cancer caused by HPV will need treatment that can sometimes limit their ability to have children. Treatments can include a hysterectomy (removal of the uterus) and therapies, such as chemo and radiation.
- Treatment for cervical pre-cancer can also result in problems with the cervix, which can sometimes result in preterm delivery.



## What is the HPV vaccine?

The infection affects about 13 million people each year, including teens. Every year, about 36,000 people develop a cancer caused by HPV. The HPV vaccine could prevent more than 90% of these cancers from ever developing. The vaccine is made from one protein from the virus and is not infectious, meaning it cannot cause HPV infection or cancer.

## Who can get the vaccine?

Everyone should get the HPV vaccine around 11 to 12 years old. It can be given as early as age 9 and until age 26.
